The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 17.08.2016, vide which a direction was issued to respondent No.2 to take a decision on the representation dated 14.01.2016, in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order and after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.

Reply on behalf of respondent is already on record. As per the said reply, the prayer of the petitioner is to allot him a plot under the employees quota. However, the entire allotment has been stayed by this Court vide order dated 29.01.2014 passed in CWP No.4205 of 2010.

In view of the above, no contempt is made out at this stage. The present contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.

However, the petitioner is at liberty to approach the concerned authority at the first instance, in case the stay is vacated or the aforesaid writ petition is decided in favour of the employees.
