Mr.Bajwa files status report by way of affidavit of Mr.Chand Singh, PPS, DSP, Circle Nabha, District Patiala which is taken on record.

Paragraphs 4 and 6 of the affidavit are reproduced as under:-

“4.That after registration of the case, the thorough investigation was conducted by ASI Jagga Ram who collected the relevant record and recorded the statements of witnesses, arrested the accused and after completion of investigation, the report U/s 173 (2) of Cr.P.C. was prepared against 23 accused persons and the challan was presented in the Ld. Trial Court on 09.02.2017. There were total 29 accused persons against whom the case was registered. However, 3 accused namely Sucha Singh son of Ram Singh, Kartar Singh son of Bant Singh and Harnam Singh son of Bhagwan Singh since expired. However, three accused namely Balwinder Singh son of Sher Singh, Gurjant Singh son of Bhagwan Singh and Ajeet Singh son of Bakhshish Singh, all residents of village Kansua Khurd are still absconding and number of

raids were effected on their house, but they are untraceable and now proceedings U/s 82, 83 of Cr.P.C. will be initiated against them in accordance with law. After their arrest, supplementary challan U/s 173 (8) of Cr.P.C. will be prepared and presented in the Court.

XXX XXX XXX

6.That as far as existing position with regard to possession is concerned, it has been apprised by the office of Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Nabha that there was 67 Bigha 8 Biswas total land of the Village Kansua Khurd under illegal possession of occupants. However, possession of land measuring 49 Bigha 4 Biswas was obtained on 28.11.2014 whereas the possession of land measuring 12 Bigha 15 Biswas was obtained on 29.8.2016. There is stay of possession on the land measuring 4 Bigha 19 Biswas by the Court. However, the existing position of possession will be submitted before the Hon’ble Court by respondent no.1.”

The position at the ground level has been explained in the affidavit.

No contempt is made out. Rule is discharged. Contempt petition is dismissed.
