Plaintiff/Petitioner alleges that the respondents are trying to take possession of the land comprised in Khasra No.136 measuring 17 Kanals 6 Marlas in the revenue estate of village Pathankot, Teshil Pathankot so as to have access to the acquired land by Improvement Trust in the adjoining Khasra No.222.

Counsel for the petitioner heard.

It is not in dispute that a Civil Suit for injunction stands filed by the petitioner/plaintiff, wherein an application for temporary injunction under Order 39 Rules 1 & 2 CPC stands filed and perhaps not decided till today. The petitioner has already filed a Civil Revision No.7471 of 2017 *inter alia* complaining that the trial court is not deciding the injunction application, wherein this Court vide order dated 31.10.2017 has already

ordered maintaining of “*Status Quo with regard to possession of Khasra no.136 be maintained*”. The said revision is now stated to be listed for hearing on 09.03.2018. As of now no contempt appears to have been committed of any order, therefore, this Court is not inclined to interfere at this stage.

Dismissed.
