The present contempt petition has been filed for non compliance of order dated 29.04.2015, vide which the directions were issued to the respondent to treat the writ petition No.8175 of 2015 titled as “Virender Kumar Gupta Versus State of Haryana and others” as a representation and decide the same by passing a speaking order.

Learned State counsel has filed status report by way of affidavit of Satinder Siwatch, Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Ambala and as per the said reply the respondent has complied with the order, by way of passing a speaking order dated 05.02.2018.

Accordingly, no contempt is made out.

The petition stands dismissed.

The rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, states that the the said order was passed while sitting at home and without any inspection made at the spot. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to challenge the said speaking order dated 05.02.2018 in accordance with law, if so advised.
