Counsel for the respondents states that in compliance with the order dated 13.10.2015 (Annexure P-1) passed by this Court in CWP No.23123 of 2014, titled as 'Urmila Yadav Vs. State of Haryana & others', filed by the petitioner, the allotment letter of a plot for petrol pump site in Sector 25, Rewari, has been issued and possession was handed over to the petitioner of the said plot, which was not accepted by her and wanted the possession to be handed over to the Indian Oil Corporation as per the terms of allotment.

Counsel for the respondents states that the possession has been handed over to the Indian Oil Corporation, which fact is not disputed by the counsel for the petitioner. He, however, states that the persons, who were in possession of the some portion of the plot were to decide some

representation which representation has been decided and on that basis, finally, as of now, writ petitions have been preferred i.e. CWP No.2855 of 2017 and CWP No.3368 of 2017, which are listed for hearing on 26.07.2018. Counsel further states that in the possession certificate which has been issued to the Indian Oil Corporation, it is mentioned that the possession is subject to the outcome of the writ petitions.

Be that as it may, the fact remains that the order, as of now, passed by this Court, contempt of which is alleged to have been made, has been complied with by the respondents. The present contempt petition, therefore, does not survive and the same stands disposed of.

The misc. applications are also stand disposed of.

Rule issued to the respondents is discharged.
