The contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 07.09.2017 vide which the order of the Deputy Commissioner-cum-District Magistrate, Hoshiarpur, was upheld directing eviction of respondent Nos.4 & 5. It is stated that eviction petition has been filed but till date no action has been taken thereon nor respondent Nos.4 & 5 have been evicted.

In view of the above, the contempt petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent-authorities to expedite the eviction petition and take appropriate action preferably within one month of the receipt of this order and take the order dated 13.12.2016 passed by the Deputy Commissioner-cum-District Magistrate, Hoshiarpur, as well as the order dated 07.09.2017 passed by the High Court, to its logical conclusion. However, if this order is not complied with, the petitioner shall be at liberty to file a fresh contempt petition.
