The case of the petitioner is for restoration of the water course at outlet RD 132730/R, Kalluana Distributary, Village Rampura Bishnoia, Tehsil Dabwali, District Sirsa was decided by the Divisional Canal Officer, Rori Water Services Division, Sirsa vide order dated 10.08.2016. The petitioner however was not satisfied and therefore filed a writ petition bearing *CWP No.2902 of 2017*, which was dismissed with costs of Rs.50,000/- vide order dated 29.08.2017 for having concealed the fact that qua the same relief temporary injunction stood already denied in the suit, filed by the petitioner, prior to the filing of the writ

petition.

Notice in the present contempt was issued only to the limited extent of non compliance of the order dated 10.08.2016, passed by the Divisional Canal Officer (D.C.O.), Sirsa.

At the time of hearing, Shri Kuldeep Nawara, Divisional Canal Officer, Sirsa, is present in Court and states that the order dated 10.08.2016 has since been complied with and the water course had made operational.

In view of the above, no further action in the present contempt is warranted.
