Petitioners approached this Court by way of CWP No.15288 of 2016 in which this Court without making any observations on merits and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition issued a direction to respondent No.2 to look into and examine the claim of the petitioners in the light of a legal notice dated 29.01.2016 . The final decision was to be taken by passing a speaking order within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of the order. The petition was disposed of on 01.08.2016.

Pursuant to the order, a speaking order has been passed on 27.02.2017 and placed on record as Annex R-1 with the written statement filed by respondent No.1.

As a result of passing of order dated 27.02.2017, nothing survives in contempt jurisdiction and, therefore, the petition is dismissed. Rule discharge.

However, the petitioner would be at liberty to move a representation for release of monetary benefits, which shall be decided by the authorities in accordance with law without delay.
