The petitioner, whose land was acquired, had filed CWP No.21588 of 2016 seeking directions to the respondent-authorities to hold the draw of lots and to allot a plot to him in Sector 25, Part-II, Panipat being the adjoining and next Sector allotted by the HUDA to Sector 29, Part-II (Industrial), Panipat. The said petition was disposed of by the Division Bench of this Court, vide order dated 19.10.2016 (**Annexure P-1**) with a direction to the respondent-authorities to take a decision on the representation dated 19.04.2016 of the petitioner, in accordance with law by passing a speaking order and after affording an opportunity of hearing within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of that order. Since the needful was not done, hence the present contempt petition.

Upon notice, reply stands filed, wherein it is submitted that the representation of the petitioner has been considered and the same has been decided by passing a speaking order dated 22.03.2017 (**Annexure R-1**).

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the present contempt petition as the aforesaid directions stand complied with.

Accordingly, the present contempt petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
