This Court, vide order dated 01.12.2017 (**Annexure P-1**) passed in *CWP No. 27371 of 2017*, had directed the Haryana Staff Selection Commission to make a recommendation to the State Government for appointment to the petitioner as Post Graduate Teacher (Home Science) in the Backward Class Category, provided the petitioner upon determination of her merit fell within the zone of the appointment against the advertised vacancies.

Since the needful was not done within the stipulated time of four weeks, hence the present contempt petition.

Upon notice, learned State Counsel has handed over a letter dated 13.03.2018 issued by the Secretary, Haryana Staff Selection Commission, Panchkula, to the Education Department, Haryana, recommending the name of the petitioner for appointment. He, thus, submits that present contempt petition has become infructuous. A copy of

the same has been retained as **Mark-A** for the purpose of record.

In view of the above, no further action is warranted in the present contempt petition.
