Petitioner (M/s Rajdeep Buildcom Private Limited) is the construction company of highways, bridges, culverts, flyovers and building etc. and had filed civil writ petition bearing *CWP No.25027 of 2017*, seeking mandamus directions to respondent No.2 therein to release the wrongfully deducted amount from RA Bill No.15 dated 30.03.2012 in violation of the agreement dated 07.07.2008, granting the concession to petitioner-company for the execution of certain works alongwith interest, was disposed of vide order dated 03.11.2017 by a Division Bench of this Court with a direction to respondent No.2 *'to take a decision on the letters and the representations/reminders dated 06.08.2014, in accordance with law by passing a speaking order and after affording an opportunity of*

hearing to the petitioner within a period of two months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the order and in case the petitioner is found entitled to the refund of the amount, the same be released to it within next one month in accordance with law.'

Since the needful was not done within the prescribed time, hence the present contempt petition.

At the time of hearing today, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the letters and the representations/reminders of the petitioner, have since been decided by the respondent, therefore, no further action in the present contempt petition is warranted, as the same has become infructuous.

Disposed of as infructuous.
