AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASI, J. (ORAL)

In compliance with the order passed by this Court on 19.05.2017 in CWP No.16301 of 2013 (Annexure P-1), initially an order was passed by the respondents on 08.12.2017 (Annexure P-2), whereby, the claim of the petitioners for regularization of their services w.e.f. 01.01.1996 was accepted. Petitioners filed the present contempt petition and on receipt of notice, respondents have proceeded to pass a fresh order dated 09.05.2018 (Annexure R-2), whereby, the earlier order which was passed in favour of the petitioners (Annexure P-2) has been withdrawn and a fresh order has been passed rejecting the claim of the petitioners. The said order has been challenged by the petitioners by filing CWP No.19301 of 2018, in which, operation of the order stands stayed vide order dated 31.08.2018.

In view of the above facts, the present contempt petition has been rendered infructuous. Disposed of as such. Liberty is, however, granted to the petitioners to file a fresh contempt petition in case their claim is finally accepted by this Court.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged.
