JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner (Gajanand) is working as JBT Teacher and is posted at GPS Gujrawas, Block Ateli, District Mohindergarh. He was claiming the benefit of the step up of his pay to the level of his juniors by filing a writ petition bearing *CWP No. 14350 of 2017*, which was disposed of by this Court vide order dated 06.07.2017 (**Annexure P-1**), directing the competent authority to look into the grievance set out in the legal notice of the petitioner and to take decision within four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

Since the needful was not done within the stipulated time, hence the present contempt petition.

Upon notice, learned State Counsel states that a sum of ₹ 2,31,551/- towards the relief claimed stands paid on 22.03.2018 to the petitioner, thus, submits that the present petition has become infructuous.

In view of the statement made on behalf of the respondent, no further action in the present contempt is warranted.

Disposed of as infructuous.
