The petitioner-Pushpa Devi Sharma has retired as a Teacher under the Directorate of Public Instructions (Elementary Education), Punjab, after attaining the age of superannuation w.e.f. 31.08.2016. This Court vide order dated 13.12.2016 (**Annexure P-1**) disposed of the writ petition bearing *CWP No.25723 of 2016*, filed by the petitioner, directing the respondents to decide the claim of the petitioner for retiral benefits.

Upon notice, a reply has been filed, wherein in Para 3, it is stated that all the retiral benefits i.e. GPF, Leave Encashment, GIS and Gratuity have been sanctioned and will be sent to the Treasury for clearance.

In view of the above, no further action in the present contempt is warranted.

Disposed of as infructuous.

However, the petitioner is given liberty to revive the same, in case the aforesaid amounts are not released within a period of one month from today.
