This Court, while issuing notice of motion, vide order dated
14.02.2018, had passed the following order:-

*“ Grievance of the petitioner is that break in service of
87 days occasioned due to non-permitting the petitioner to
join on his place of posting as Lecturer in Sociology due to
post not being vacant, was ordered to be decided within three
months vide order dated 6.10.2017.*

*Compliance report be submitted one week in advance,
failing which the costs of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand

Upon notice, short reply of Shri Rajiv Rattan, Director Secondary Education, Haryana, Panchkula/respondent No.2, has been filed in Court today, which is taken on record.

In the reply, it is stated that the case of the petitioner has been examined and the period from 06.04.2016 to 01.07.2016 (87 days) has been treated as duty period for all the intents and purposes vide order dated 26.02.2018 (**Annexure R-I**), copy of which is also conveyed to the petitioner.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the parties submit that no further action in the present contempt is warranted, as the same has become infructuous.

Disposed of as infructuous.
