The petitioner is the complaint in FIR No.2 dated 5.1.2016 for offences punishable under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 448 and 120-B registered with Police Station Sultanwind, Amritsar. Since no substantial investigations were undertaken, he filed CRM-M No.28882 of 2017 which was disposed of vide order dated 24.08.2017 with the direction to the police authorities to decide the representation within three months.

At the time of hearing realizing that the proper remedy for the petitioner is under Section 156(3) Cr.PC, counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the present petition.
