This Court vide interim order dated 09.01.2018 passed in CWP No.40 of 2018 directed the BSF Authorities to permit the petitioner to participate in the process of selection of Constables in the Meritorious Sports Quota.

The present contempt was filed with the allegations that the petitioner was not permitted to join the selection process conducted on 10.01.2018 at Jalandhar.

Upon an inquiry Mr. Shivor Dhir, Central Government Counsel informs the Court that vide order dated 20.02.2018 the petitioner has been asked to appear on 26.02.2018 at 95 Btn. BSF, Bhondsi, Gurgaon, Haryana for facing scrutiny/selection process in terms of the order dated 09.10.2018.

In view of the above, no further proceedings are warranted in

the present contempt petition.
