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**JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)**

It was contended that the respondent-mother/mother-in-law is not honoring her commitment to pay a sum of Rs.4 lacs by 31.12.2017, in view of the settlement acknowledged in the order dated 2.6.2017 (Annexure P-1) passed by this Court in CWP No.11381 of 2017, despite the petitioners having performed their part of the settlement.

Learned counsel for the respondent submits that an application bearing CM No.18668 of 2017 has been filed in the writ petition concerned, i.e. CWP No.11381 of 2017, seeking extension of time for depositing a sum of Rs.4 lacs, however, a sum of Rs.2 lacs payable in the name of Sunil Kumar by way of two demand drafts of Rs.1 lac each have been tendered and accepted in Court on behalf of Sunil Kumar by his counsel towards part

payment of the aforesaid amount.

Photocopies of the two demand drafts bearing Nos.173136, dated 19.12.2017 and 173280 dated 12.02.2018 have been retained for the purpose of record.

Learned counsel for the respondent states that the remaining amount of Rs.2 lacs would be paid by 31.07.2018, as prayed for, in the application seeking extension of time in the original writ petition.

In view of the above, this Court is not inclined to proceed any further with the present contempt petition, therefore, the same is **disposed of**.
