Petitioner filed a suit for injunction qua the property in question and was also an defendant in a suit for specific performance qua the same property. Both the suits have ended in favour of the present petitioner right uptill the second appeal decided by this Court. Since the suit for injunction stood decreed, the present contempt has been filed alleging that the judgment debtor-respondent no.4- Thakur Rajiv Singh along with the police officials/respondent nos.1 to 3 are threatening the possession of the petitioner in violation of the said decree.

At the time of hearing, realising that the decree is executable under Order 21 Rule 32 CPC, counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the present petition.
