JASWANT SINGH, J.(ORAL)

Petitioner is stated to be fruit merchant operating from Plot No.12, Transport Area, Sector 26, Chandigarh. There was an auction scheduled on 19.10.2017 where on three police officials from Kullu, Himachal Pradesh had slapped him and taken away the money bag. One Kamlesh Sharma with whom the petitioner have financial dealings was also accompanying them. No action was taken by the local police and, therefore, the representation dated 18.10.2017 was made to SSP, U.T., Chandigarh. The petitioner filed CRM-M No.40538 of 2017 seeking a direction for taking action against the private respondent and for protection of life and liberty. The said petition was disposed of vide order dated 30.10.2017 directing the SSP, Chandigarh to look into the grievance as set out in the representation and take necessary action.

The present contempt has been filed alleging no action has been taken.

After hearing learned Counsel for the petitioner, no ground for invoking the contempt jurisdiction is made out. Petitioner is free to seek his remedy by filing criminal complaint or availing any other remedy in accordance with law.

Dismissed with aforesaid liberty.
