Separate affidavits of the Deputy Commissioner, Jalandhar and the District Development and Panchayat Officer, Jalandhar have been filed in Court, which are taken on record. According to the said affidavits, a petition under Section 7 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 read with Sections 5 and 7 of the Public Premises (Eviction of Unauthorized Occupants) Act, 1971, has been filed against the illegal occupants, which proceedings are in progress. FIR No.1372 of 2017, under Sections 447 and 149 of IPC, was also registered at Police Station Phillaur, District Jalandhar and thereafter, challan has also been presented against the illegal occupants.

In view of the affidavits referred to above, the present contempt petition has been rendered infructuous. Disposed of as such.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged.
