Learned counsel for the respondents, with reference to the affidavit dated 21.03.2018 filed by the Superintending Engineer, BWS Circle, Sirsa, states that the order passed by this Court has been duly complied with as the pay of the petitioner has been refixed by granting him the technical pay-scale. An amount of ₹ 8,37,408/- has also been released to the petitioner as arrears.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. In case the petitioner is aggrieved by the non-payment of interest, which counsel states the petitioner is entitled to in the light fact that the writ petition was allowed in the year 2012 and the payment has been made now, he may avail of his remedy in accordance with law.
