The contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of the order dated 29.09.2017 vide which a direction was issued to decide legal notice of the petitioners dated 18.07.2017.

Reply has been filed. As per the said reply, the service record of the petitioners has been considered after the same was received from the field office and the petitioners have been granted the benefit of stepping-up of pay at par with their junior, vide orders dated 15.05.2018 and 18.05.2018.

In view of the above, the contempt petition is rendered infructuous and is dismissed accordingly.

Rule discharged.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners states that no interest has been paid. There is no such direction in the order. However, if the petitioners are still aggrieved, they are at liberty to make representation within four weeks from today seeking interest. If such a representation is made, the respondent shall decide the same within three months of the receipt of such representation.
