The contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of the order dated 10.07.2014. Various status reports were filed. On the last date of hearing, directions were issued to file a specific affidavit as to whether all the other slaughter houses or slaughter of animals being carried out in the shops or in the open market have ceased to continue.

Compliance report by way of affidavit of Ravneet Singh, Executive Officer, Municipal Council, Rajpura, District Patiala has been filed. As per said affidavit, the slaughter house at Rajpura was constructed and made operational w.e.f. 21.10.2018 and that at present the slaughtering of animals is only being done at the aforementioned newly constructed slaughter house and no slaughtering of animals is taking place at any other shop/place within the Municipal limits of Municipal Council, Rajputa.

In view of the above, there is no necessity to continue with these contempt proceedings.

The contempt petition is disposed of.
