Prayer in this contempt petition is to summon the respondents and punish them for wilfully, consciously and deliberately violating/disobeying the order dated 1.6.2017 (Annexure P-1) passed by this Court in CWP No.12846 of 2017 filed by the petitioners, whereby the respondents were directed to get the high tension wires shifted from the residential plots of the petitioners within a period of three months.

Affidavit of the Estate Officer-1, Haryana Shehri Vikas Pradhikaran, Gurugram has been filed in Court. Same is taken on record.

Copy thereof has been supplied to the counsel opposite.

According to the said affidavit, a speaking order dated 23.7.2018 (Annexure R-1) has been passed.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the order passed by this Court stands complied with.

In view of the above, present contempt petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.
