The petitioner was claiming to be in possession of a portion of land comprised in Khasra No.101 total measuring 369 kanals and 6 marlas and claiming compensation in view of acquisition of entire land in the said khasra number for construction of railway freight corridor. The Division Bench of this Court vide order dated 08.4.2015 disposed of the writ petition filed by the petitioner with a direction to the respondent to pass a speaking order.

Upon notice, reply stands filed. Learned counsel for the respondent points out that a speaking order dated 26.5.2016 (Annexure R-2) has been passed, wherein it has been asserted that the entire land comprised

in Khasra No.101 of village Roj-Ka-Meo was recorded in the ownership of Gram Panchayat, to whom the entire compensation stands released.

In view of the above, no further action is warranted in the present contempt petition.
