Plaintiffs-petitioners are in the revision petition against the order passed by the learned trial Court closing the opportunity to lead evidence on the ground that sufficient opportunities have been granted including last opportunity.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that only the revenue record i.e. copies of Jamabandi and an order passed by the Collector is to be filed which are per se admissible.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the respondent has submitted that several opportunities have already been granted including the last opportunity and therefore, the petitioners should not be granted any opportunity.

Taking into consideration the prayer made, it is considered appropriate that the plaintiffs-petitioners be granted one opportunity to

place on record copies of the revenue record and the order passed by the Collector. However, this opportunity shall be subject to the payment of costs of Rs.5,000/-.

Revision petition is allowed.
