Learned counsel for the respondent-State on instructions from Sh. S. P. Singh, XEN, PWD (B&R) submits that in some of the cases payments have been received by the petitioners and in some cases payments will be released in the month of April only.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for respondent-State, the present contempt petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent to release the payment if not released earlier within a period of one month only. In case the payment is not released within a period of one month, petitioner will be entitled to interest @ 9% per annum.

The contempt petition is disposed of.

In case the payment is not released within the aforesaid

period, petitioner is also at liberty to move an application for recalling of the order.
