In compliance with the order passed by this Court on 01.05.2017 in CWP No. 1503 of 2015, whereby the petitioner was held entitled for all service benefits including monetary benefits from the date his junior Sh. Atul Kumar was extended the benefit of promotion to the post of Assistant, the respondents have released the consequential benefits including the retiral benefits as also the arrears along with interest.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that all the benefits, which the petitioner has claimed, have not been released to him.

A perusal of the order dated 01.05.2017 passed by this Court indicates that the benefit, which the petitioner was held entitled to, as per the said order, was limited to the extent that the same was released to the junior of the petitioner and that too, from the date he was promoted on the post of Assistant.

In the considered view of this Court, the order passed by this

Court stands duly complied with rendering the present contempt petition infructuous.

Disposed of as infructuous.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged.
