Reply on behalf of respondents has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

Writ petition filed by petitioners was disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 (SDM-cum-Land Acquisition Collector) by treating the petition as an application on behalf of petitioners under Sections 23 & 28 of the Land Acquisition Act read with National Highways Act, 1956 and to determine their claim regarding grant of solatium and interest within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. It was also directed that amount due be released by respondent No.1 & 3 within a period of one month thereafter.

Learned counsel for respondents submits that as per direction issued by the Division Bench on 24.07.2014 the claim of the petitioners

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has been considered and FDRs have been prepared but the payment is to be released by Sub Divisional Magistrate. Vide order dated 24.07.2014 a specific direction was issued to release the amount by respondent Nos.1&3.

Accordingly, respondents are directed to deposit the FDRs so prepared with the competent authority within a period of ten days and to hand over to the petitioners by the competent authority within a period of one week thereafter. In case the compliance is not made within the aforesaid period, the petitioners shall be entitled to interest @ 18% per annum.
