Petitioners had approached this Court alleging non-compliance of the order dated 07.09.2016 passed by this Court in CWP No.18519 of 2016 preferred by the petitioners, which was disposed of by directing the respondents to verify the records and decide petitioners' claim by passing a speaking order within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

After issuance of notice, a reply has been filed by respondent No.2, according to which the claim of the petitioners was considered and rejected by passing a speaking order dated 15.03.2017 (Annexure R-1).

In view of the above, the order passed by this Court stands duly complied with.

In case the petitioners are aggrieved by the order passed by the respondents, they may avail of the remedy in accordance with law.

The contempt petition stands disposed of.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged.
