Petitioners have filed the present contempt petition under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 seeking initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent for violating the order dated 02.03.2017 (P-1) passed by this Court in CWP No.1461 of 2017 directing the respondent to consider the case and pass a speaking order, in case the Petitioners are not entitled to the benefit prayed for. Since the needful was not done within time, hence the present contempt petition.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the respondent has filed compliance report by way of affidavit of Sukhdev Singh, Director SCERT, Punjab and in para 3 of the same, it is stated that the case of the petitioner has been considered and found to be on similar footing for grant

of grace marks and revised the result of the petitioner in view of LPA No.1064 of 2015 and as such the present contempt petition has become infructuous.

In view of the aforesaid stand of the respondents, the present contempt petition is hereby dismissed as infructuous.
