The contempt petition has been filed for non compliance of order dated 26.4.2016 passed the Family Court, Gurgaon vide which a direction was issued to allow the petitioner to meet the child on the first and third week of every English Calender month during a week day after giving three days a prior notice to the respondent. He shall be entitled to keep the child from 4.00 PM to 8.00 PM.

Today the learned counsel for the parties have jointly agreed that the contempt petition can be disposed of with modification of the order dated 26.04.2016 to the extent that the petitioner shall be entitled to meet the child on the 1st and 3rd week of every English Calender month during a week day after giving three days prior notice to the respondent, but in case the said arrangement fails during the 1st and 3rd week, the same shall be carried over to the 2nd and 4th week.

Ordered accordingly.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is disposed of accordingly. The rest of the directions of the order dated 26.04.2016 shall also be continued to be complied with.
