Petitioner is stated to have inherited the property bequeathed by his maternal grandmother (*Naani*) by virtue of a Will to the exclusion of the maternal uncles of the petitioner, who are stated to be NRIs residing in Canada. The petitioner has been granted an ex-parte decree of declaration of title based on the Will. The maternal uncles have filed a complaint before the Police Station NRI, Ferozepur alleging cheating etc. at the hands of the petitioner, wherein the SHO concerned had issued a notice under Section 160 Cr.PC. The said action of the SHO was challenged by the petitioner by filing CWP No.28439 of 2017, wherein while issuing notice of motion for 29.01.2018, the summoning of the petitioner by the SHO concerned was ordered to be stayed.

The present contempt has been filed with the allegations that

inspite of the interim order dated 10.01.2018, the SHO concerned is time

and again calling the petitioner to the Police Station, however, he concedes that neither any notice under Section 160 Cr.PC has been issued nor any attempt has been made to arrest the petitioner.

After arguing for sometime, learned Counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the present contempt petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
