In pursuance to order dated 16.07.2018, reply has been filed on behalf of respondent No.1 in Court, which is taken on record. Copy supplied to counsel opposite.

However, costs has not been paid inspite of the fact that the reply has not been filed as a direction was issued vide order dated 16.07.2018 to deposit the amount of Rs.10,000/- as costs.

As per the said reply, the order has been complied with. The electric connection has not been disconnected and the petitioner may be permitted to pay the energy bill as raised in the last cycle.

In view of the same, the contempt petition is dismissed.
