The writ petition bearing *CWP No. 7946 of 2017* filed by the petitioner-Construction Company seeking mandamus directing the respondents to release the due amounts *qua* work executed by the petitioner-company, was disposed of vide order dated 20.04.2017 (**Annexure P-1**) by this Court with a direction to the Executive Engineer, Ropar Head Works Division, Ropar, to consider the legal notice dated 20.03.2017 within a period two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and shall pass a speaking order thereon and if the claim of the petitioner is found justified, the payment shall be released to the petitioner within a period of two weeks thereafter.

Since the needful was not done within the stipulated time,
hence the present contempt petition.

Upon notice, counsel for the respondent(s), on instructions from Mr. Vijay Kumar Garg, Executive Engineer, Ropar Head Works Division, Ropar (respondent No. 4), states that all the amounts due in compliance of the order dated 20.04.2017 **(P-1)** passed by this Court have since been released, therefore, nothing more survives for adjudication in the present contempt petition.

Counsel for the petitioner also concedes the aforesaid factual position and prays for withdrawal the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
