The contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of the order dated 11.3.2016 vide which a direction was issued to the Management to disburse the amount of leave encashment to each of the petitioners.

Reply has been filed. As per the reply, the order dated 11.03.2016 has been complied with and the amount of leave encachment alongwith interest stands disbursed in the accounts of the petitioners. The respondent has also placed on record receipts of the payment of leave encashment as Annexure R-2 & R-3.

In this view of the matter the contempt petition does not survive and the same is disposed of accordingly. In case there is any discrepancy in the amount so paid, the petitioners shall be at liberty to make a representation within four weeks and in case such representation is made, the respondent shall consider and decide the same in accordance with law.
