This order shall disposed of two contempt petitions bearing
COCP Nos.978 and 986 of 2018.

It is not disputed that while deciding the comprehensive
representation(s) in terms of the order dated 06.10.2016 and 07.10.2016, the
benefits as per the entitlement have since been released. The only dispute is
with respect to the payment of the interest. Admittedly, there was no prayer
for grant of interest either in the representation and nor any such order was
passed.

In view of the above, the present contempt petitions are
dismissed.

However, the petitioners are at liberty to make a representation
qua the interest amount within two weeks from the date of receipt of
certified copy of this order, which shall be decided by the respondent, in
accordance with law.
