This petition has been filed against the order dated 8.12.2012 passed by the learned Rent Controller, Hoshiarpur evicting the petitioner from the demised premises.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, states that the petitioner will not press this petition on merits and will vacate the premises voluntarily on or before 30.6.2019 without forcing the respondent to file an execution petition. He undertakes to pay the entire rent upto that date within a period of two months from today.

Learned counsel for the respondent, on instructions, has also

accepted this offer on the condition that the petitioner will file an undertaking to the above effect before the Rent Controller within within the aforesaid two months, with the condition that in the event of any default, this petition should be deemed to be dismissed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has accepted this condition.

The revision petition is disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
