1. Whether the Reporters of local newspaper may be allowed to see the judgment ?

KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in the contempt application pending before the civil Court since the year 2010, he was granted first opportunity to lead evidence on 08.11.2017. After granting five opportunities by giving short dates, his evidence was closed by orders.

It is further contended that this will cause irreparable damage to the respondent, who may be convicted for committing disobedience of the order of the Court.

In these circumstances, without issuing notice to the opposite party, the petitioner is given one more opportunity to conclude his evidence on the date fixed by the trial Court for this purpose, subject to payment of costs of ₹2,000/- payable to the opposite party.

As such, the present revision petition is allowed.
