Defendant No.6-petitioner is in the revision petition against the order passed by the learned First Appellate Court. While issuing notice of motion, this Court had passed the order dated 13.03.2015 which reads as under:-

“This is a revision petition preferred by defendant No.6. The application under Order 39 Rules 1 & 2 CPC filed by the plaintiffs-respondents was dismissed holding that petitioner-defendant Nos.6 & 7 were not restrained from alienating the property. The lower appellate Court has allowed the application for interim injunction partly holding that the parties will maintain status quo regarding the possession. However, the property will not be alienated by the defendant-petitioner Nos.6 & 7 during pendency of the suit.

Aggrieved by the order of restraint, defendant No.6 has filed this petition claiming that sale if any certainly would be subject to principle of lis pendens and that the plaintiffs prima facie have no right to file the suit.

Notice of motion to respondent Nos.1 to 3 for 15.5.2015.

Meanwhile, it is directed that in case the petitioner-defendant No.6 intends to alienate the property she would disclose the names of the prospective vandeas to the trial Court and would intimate the Court regarding the proposed sale.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner very fairly submits that defendant No.6 has already alienated the property and information in this regard has been given to the Court. He submits that hence, his grievance has been redressed and he has instructions not to press this revision petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.
