The petitioner has assailed the order dated 25.02.2018 passed by District Judge, Narnaul vide which application for transfer of two suits titled as Smt. Murti and another Versus Chajju Ram and others and Jagdish Versus Pawan Kumar and others was dismissed.

A suit for permanent injunction was filed by Smt. Murti against Chajju Ram and others. The said suit was fixed for rebuttal. In the aforesaid suit, counter claim was setup by the petitioner seeking declaration of title on the basis of inheritance. During the pendency of the suit some part of the property is alleged to have been transferred by Smt. Murti in favour of respondent No. 3 - Sunheri Devi. Smt. Sunheri Devi further

transferred the property in favour of respondents No. 4 to 6. Smt. Murti further sold some portion of the land in favour of Pawan Kumar. Second suit was filed by Jagdish. The said transfer was assailed in a declaratory suit. Second suit was fixed for evidence of the plaintiff. Apparently, different properties are involved. The parties to the litigation are also not the same. Both the cases are pending at different stages in different Courts. No prayer for the consolidation of the suits can be entertained.

In view of the aforesaid facts, this revision petition is found to be totally devoid of any merits and the same is dismissed, accordingly.
