Plaintiff-petitioner is in the revision petition against the order dated 21.11.2017 closing her evidence after noticing that 8 effective opportunities have been granted.

Learned counsel for the plaintiff has drawn the attention of the Court to the zimini orders passed by the Court on various hearings and has submitted that on two occasions the case was adjourned as counsel for the defendant made a request for an adjournment for completing the cross-examination of PW1-Ranjit Kaur.

Although, the Court has already granted sufficient opportunities, however, taking into consideration, the zimini orders which have been reproduced, this Court is of the considered opinion that the plaintiff be granted one effective opportunity to conclude her entire evidence. Hence, revision is allowed, plaintiff is granted one effective opportunity to conclude her entire evidence subject to the payment of cost of Rs.10,000/-.

Since the order has been passed without issuing notice, the defendants shall be at liberty to move an application for recalling the order, if necessity arises.
