Mr. Ashok Bhardwaj, Advocate has caused appearance on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2.

Counsel for respondents No.1 and 2 would state that grievance expressed by the petitioner in the present petition already stands redressed in view of statements made by counsel for respondents No.2 and 3 before the Rent Controller whereby he has stated that he has got no objection if cross examination already conducted by him on RW1 is expunged and he gives up right to cross examine witnesses of respondent No.1 as well as respondent No.1 on behalf of respondents No.2 and 3.
