Petitioner-objector is in the revision petition against the order passed by learned First Appellate Court refusing to stay the execution of a decree which has been upheld upto this Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that the learned First Appellate Court be directed to decide the first appeal on an early date.

It is clear from the reading of the order that the service is complete. The record of the trial Court was requisitioned and the case was fixed for arguments.
