Through the instant petition, challenge is made to the order dated 10.12.2014, passed by the Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Dasuya (for short, the Trial Court), through which the respondent, who is the petitioner's minor son, has been held entitled to a monthly maintenance of ₹8,000/-.

On a query posed, learned counsel for the petitioner admits that an amount of ₹2,30,000/- towards arrears of maintenance is due. Learned counsel for the respondent submits that he cannot verify the exact due amount but does say that at least ₹2,30,000/- is due from the petitioner.

In view of the above admission, the petitioner disentitles himself to be even to be heard on merits.

Even otherwise, it is the admitted position that the petitioner is serving as an Assistant Professor in a private college and is owner of 36 kanals and 6 marlas of agricultural land which he has given on lease. The relationship of the parties is also admitted. That being so, no error can be found in the awarded monthly maintenance of ₹8,000/- to the respondent.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.

It is clarified that aforesaid due amount shall be deposited by the petitioner before the Executing Court within six weeks from today where the matter is stated to be pending. This shall be in addition to the future maintenance to be paid to the respondent till the time the custody of the respondent is not with the petitioner for which admittedly proceedings are pending.
