This petition has been filed challenging the order of the appellate authority declining prayer for stay as well as an order of the Executing Court dismissing the objection petition.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that on the one hand the landlord-respondent was prosecuting the executing petition but on the other hand he was not appearing in the appeal. Counsel for the respondent on the other hand states that actually the conduct of the petitioner-tenant is very shady because he is not paying rent for the last two decades. Be that as it may, now learned counsel for the respondent is agreed that respondent will appear before the appellate authority on the next date i.e. 11.5.2018 and, till then he will not press the execution application.

Consequently, the appeal stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
