Plaintiff-petitioner is in revision petition with a prayer that learned trial Court be directed to record her statement and decide the application for permission to sue as a pauper under Order 33 of the Code of Civil Procedure.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has drawn the attention of the Court to various orders passed by the Courts on various hearings. It has been contended that initially the Court asked for the report of the Collector which was received on 01.12.2015. Thereafter, the case was adjourned for the statement of the plaintiff.
