Revision petition is for issuance of directions to the Executing Court i.e. learned Addl. District Judge, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhri, to decide Execution Application No.581 of 2016, titled Banarsi Dass vs. State of Haryana and others, for execution of award dated 03.03.2010, passed in land acquisition case No.157 of 2007, as modified by the High Court, vide judgment dated 05.05.2016, in RFA No.3293 of 2010. Prayer is for directions to the learned executing court to conclude the execution proceedings within a stipulated period of time.

Learned counsel relies upon order in similar circumstances dated 20.12.2017 passed in CR No.8942 of 2017 in case titled 'Ramesh Kumar and another vs. State of Haryana and others', as well as order dated 06.02.2018 in CR No.583 of 2018, in case titled 'Parveen Kumar and others vs. State of Haryana and others', whereby the learned executing court was directed to dispose of the execution proceedings within 6 months from date of order.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Tanisha Peshawaria, learned DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. She states that she has no objection to the limited prayer of the petitioner.

In the circumstances, the revision petition is disposed of by directing the learned Executing Court to decide Execution Application No.581 of 2016, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within 6 months from today.

With aforesaid direction, the revision petition is disposed of.
