The order passed by the learned trial Court dated 16.02.2017 has been challenged by way of present revision petition. On 31.01.2017, the learned trial Court had framed additional issues and granted opportunity to both the parties to lead evidence. Now by way of impugned order, the learned trial Court has struck off the evidence recorded on the ground that that is beyond the scope of the order.

In the considered opinion of this Court, this issue could not have been examined by the learned trial Court at this stage. The Court would be in a better position to examine this aspect only at the time of final adjudication of the case.

In view thereof, the order under challenge is set aside.

Revision petition is allowed.
